I am requesting funding for Anniston Army Depot Access Control Point project for the Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Anniston Army Depot 7 Frankford Ave Anniston, AL 36201. The project allows Anniston Army Depot (ANAD) with an efficient Main Gate and Entry Control Facilities (ECF). The main gate and entrance control facilities should include an Access Control Point (ACP), Commercial Vehicle Inspection Facility (CVIF), Visitor Control Center (VCC), and roadway infrastructure necessary to provide efficient incoming and outgoing flow from ANAD. The project is a good use of taxpayer dollars because it will provide Anniston Army Depot with funding to for necessary utility services and connections, fire protection, parking areas, information systems, signage, site improvements, and demolition of currently utilized facilities that are replaced as part of the project.
